Sir,

This has reference to your RTI application registered online vide Registration No. OISDE/R/E/20/00001 dated 08.02.2020 received online through GOI RTI portal.

As desired, we furnish below the reply to the information sought as available, in seriatim.

Query:

The queries pertain to recently revised standard OISD STD 112 in August 2019. The standard has included certain clauses related to handling of Triethylaluminium (TEAL) under section 6.3. Clause 6.3.2 first bulleted point prescribes the Oxygen and moisture content of Nitrogen used for pressurization, flushing and as a blanketing material to be restricted below 0.1 ppm.

Please provide me following information in this regard.

1. Please let me know whether the level of 0.1 ppm is to be considered as 0.1 ppm by volume or 0.1 ppm by weight.
2. Whether the level 0.1 ppm implies the summation of oxygen and moisture together or it implies less than 0.1 ppm oxygen and 0.1 ppm moisture separately.
3. Please clarify the significance of the value of 0.1 ppm.
4. Whether the level of 0.1 ppm is detectable by any online or offline instrument. In case if the level of 0.1 ppm is not detectable what value of oxygen and moisture should be considered appropriate?
5. Whether this provision is required to be followed mandatorily by all new process units and existing process units too.

Reply:

Information sought doesn't fall within the ambit of the Right to Information Act, 2005.
